The Evanston RoundTable's journalists, photographers and designers have received approximately 150 journalism awards from the Northern Illinois Newspaper Association in the last 10 years, and its journalists have been finalists on about 10 occasions for Lisagor awards from the Chicago Headline Club, the largest chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists.

The RoundTable has also earned the respect of the community and received awards from many community groups. These include:

- “newspaper publishing excellence,” (the Annual Donald R. Grubb Award, presented by the Journalism Department, Northern Illinois University, DeKalb);
- “best education reporting” and “best editorials in a community newspaper” (Lisagor awards, Chicago Headline Club);
- “long-standing excellence in reporting,” (Studs Terkel Award, Community Media Workshop);
- “commitment to honest and faithful reporting and true interest in community issues (Evanston/North Shore Branch of the NAACP);
- “addressing topics of importance to the community, including mental health and social issues (Community Partnership Award, Housing Options, now Impact Behavior Health);
- “supporting early child care and education” (Childcare Network of Evanston); and
- Small Business Person of the Year Award from the Evanston Chamber of Commerce.
